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Purpose

Provide first aid support and oversee player safety during IYBL practices, games, and events. Ensure immediate care is available for players (K4–Grade 8), and coordinate with emergency medical services when advanced care is needed.

Reports to

League Coordinator

Supervises

N/A (works collaboratively with coaches, referees, and event team members)

Key Responsibilities

- Provide on-site medical coverage during league events (Jamborees, practices, and games).
- Administer first aid for minor injuries and monitor player health.
- Evaluate situations and, when necessary, activate emergency medical services (911).
- Communicate with parents and league team members about injuries and care provided.
- Maintain and oversee first aid supplies.
- Assist with setup and breakdown of medical/safety stations.
- Complete basic injury and incident reports.

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Essential Qualifications

- CPR & First Aid certification (required).
- Experience working with children or youth in a care, health, or sports setting.
- Ability to remain calm and professional in emergencies.
- Strong communication skills with children, parents, and team members.
- Reliable and responsible.

Preferred Qualifications

- Background in sports medicine, nursing, physical therapy, or athletic training (not required).
- Prior experience providing medical coverage at youth or school sporting events.
